Day 1 Depart USA

Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Venice, Italy.

Day 2 Venice, Italy

Your Croatian cruise begins in the romantic city of Venice. You'll be transferred to your Emerald Cruises luxury yacht to embark on a compelling journey of history, art and natural wonders. **Meal: D**

Day 3 Rovinj, Croatia

The town of Rovinj on the Istrian Peninsula is threaded with Italian influence. Guests love the winding city streets, picturesque harbor and colorful building façades. It's a lovely, walkable town and there are plenty of art galleries, small squares and a harbor dotted with fishing boats.

Day 4 Šibenik

Today we visit Šibenik, nestled in a sea inlet on Croatia's Adriatic coast. The origins of Šibenik date back to 1066 and there is a plethora of architectural styles to admire. Don't miss the UNESCO World Heritage-listed St James' Cathedral, crafted from white stone – just take the stairs from the Riva, the seaside promenade. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 5 Trogir

The tiny town of Trogir is a hidden gem, located on a small island between the mainland and Ciovo Island. For some of the most spectacular views of this photogenic town, climb the tower of the Cathedral of St Lawrence – it's the highest building in Trogir. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 6 Visa - Hvar

The island of Vis, off the Croatian mainland, was closed to visitors until 1989. This has given Vis a rare sense of peace and authenticity. Its rocky coastline, azure waters and Venetian architecture made it the ideal backdrop of the film 'Mamma Mia! Here We Go Again.' (2018). As the afternoon rolls in, it's time to set sail to Hvar. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 7 Hvar

The heart of island paradise Hvar is the Old Town – while it's become a modern-day hotspot, it's layered in history and architectural wonder. The town of Hvar is a photogenic jumble of whitewashed buildings with sun-kissed red roofs, and beyond the town are rolling hills peppered with lavender fields, olive groves, and grapevines. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 8 Korčula - Dubrovnik

The sixth-largest island in the Adriatic, Korčula, is among the most beloved in Croatia. Its Old Town, referred to by the locals as 'Little Dubrovnik', is a delightful collection of medieval churches, palaces, and squares, while the villages of Cara and Smokvica produce the country's signature dry white wine. You will sail to Dubrovnik later in the day.

Day 9 Dubrovnik, Croatia

Your Emerald Cruises voyage concludes in the grand, historic city of Dubrovnik. From the yacht, you will be transferred to the airport for your journey home or to continue your holiday. **Meal: B**

Return air transportation is included ONLY if your air tickets are purchased through Mayflower Cruises & Tours. Please review the Plan for details on coverage.

Should you choose not to purchase our TPP, the following per person cancellation charges will be assessed for all tours and optional excursion costs:

- 121 days or more prior to departure: Deposit Amount
- 120 days until day of departure: 100% of total tour
- No refund on unused portions of the tour
